Good Morning and Welcome to Pavilion Christian Community,

Our theme this week is that of sacrifice, defined in the Oxford Dictionary as “an act of giving up something one values for the sake of something that is of greater importance.” I was thinking about this whilst preparing for the “Marriage Preparation Course” which Sarah and I are hosting. The topic covered shared goals and values and areas where we might need to make sacrifices for one another. Often we associate the word “sacrifice” within relationship terms with something of a compromise for one party or another. I’ll give up my football at the weekend if you give up your nightly keep fit class, or if it will keep you happy etc.etc. That is not the sort of sacrifice that Jesus made. Jesus made His sacrifice anyway and then invited us to share in what it means. He had no guarantees from us, but to Him, we were and are of “greater importance” than His own body. He simply chose to make an absolute sacrifice, a true sacrifice, freely and asking nothing from us in return other than we accept it and accept Him.
